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How It Works

- Students are divided into classes according to age and ability.
- Classes are 50 minutes long.
- Classes are scheduled between 3:30-6:30 on weekday afternoons.
- Classes involve the introduction and practice of new techniques, a theory lesson, and individual attention to a student choice piece.
- Students sign up for a semester of lessons at a time. There are two semesters a year. (Fall and Spring) The fall semester begins in August, and the spring semester begins in January.
- We also offer a summer session for students who would like a little extra practice.
- Students graduate from one level and move to the next after two semesters.
- We offer one makeup lesson day per month.
- We will follow the school calendar. School vacations are vacations at Note-Worthy.

How Much It Costs

- The monthly fee for our classes is \$60.00 a month per student.
- Students pay a \$60.00 deposit at the beginning of each semester which counts as their payment the last month of the semester. Any student no longer enrolled by the last month of the semester loses his/her deposit.
- Students pay for class books and other music they choose to play.
